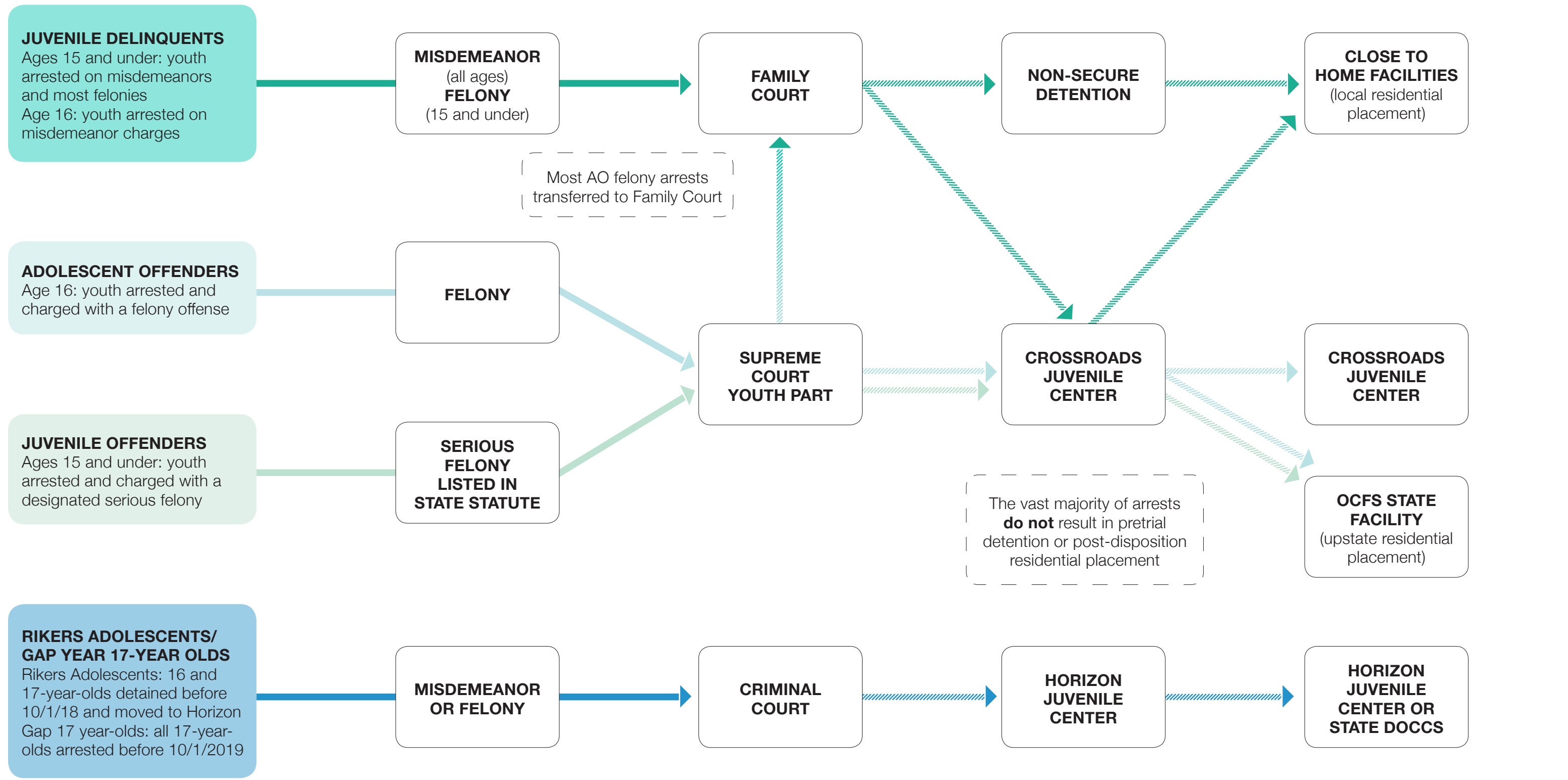


# Raise the Age: HOW YOUTH MAY BE INCARCERATED

October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019



## ARREST CHARGE

\*NYPD Juvenile Crime Desk reviews all JD misdemeanor arrests and recommends whether arrest is appropriate

## COURT

\*Family Court: Probation assesses all cases, can "adjust" cases immediately, diverting them from prosecution \*Youth Part: District Attorneys must present compelling evidence to keep felony cases (AOs)

## DETENTION FACILITY

\*If judge orders youth to be detained while the case proceeds, they will go to either secure or non-secure detention, determined by case details

## PLACEMENT FACILITY

\*If youth is found guilty/receives a JD finding, and a judge imposes an incarcerative sentence, the youth will go to a city or state facility, determined by case type and sentence length
