


How many people with open criminal cases are re-arrested?

All Citywide Docketed Arrests Each Month



Most Serious Charge at Arraignment



All Citywide Docketed VFO Arrests Each Month





How much does the pretrial population contribute to overall citywide docketed arrests?

Most docketed arrests citywide are of people who do NOT already have another pending case (75% in September, down from 81% in 2019 as arrests among the non-pretrial population plummeted in 2020). Pretrial rearrests make up a smaller proportion of total docketed arrests. There is a steep decline in docketed arrests with no pending case, and a slight decline among those with a pending case.

On Pretrial Release for Pending Case



Of all docketed arrests in September, only about 6% already had a pending VFO case at the time of their new arrest. Another 6% had a pending NVF, and 14% had a pending misdemeanor (because there were almost 30,000 people in the community pretrial on a misdemeanor September, though less than 4% of those were rearrested that month).



Most docketed VFO arrests citywide are also of people who do NOT have a pending case (74% in September). Any bumps in docketed VFO arrests among the pretrial population tend to coincide with larger bumps in docketed VFO arrests among the non-pretrial population.

On Pretrial Release for Pending Case



Of all docketed VFO arrests citywide in September, only about 8% had a pending VFO case. Another 6% had a pending NVF, and 13% had a pending misdemeanor (again, because there were so many people with a pending misdemeanor, though most are not rearrested).

Type of Pending Case





How does the pretrial population fare each month, in terms of rearrest?

Of the almost 50,000 people who were awaiting resolution of their case in the community in September, 97% were not rearrested at all during the month, and over 99% were not rearrested on a VFO.

All People Citywide in the Community with a Pending Case: % Rearrested Each Month



Most people awaiting their case resolution in the community each month are not rearrested regardless of the pretrial conditions under which they are waiting. In September:


- 97% of people with DATs or ROR'd, 96% of people who posted bail and 94% on SR were not rearrested at all
- 99% of people with DATs, ROR'd, posted bail or were on SR were not rearrested for a VFO

Of the ~3-5% who are rearrested each month, most new arrests are for misdemeanors or non-violent felonies.

Rearrests of the population in the community each month, by pretrial status





Most pretrial rearrests happen among the ROR'd population, including VFO rearrests, because even though the rearrest rate for ROR'd people is very low, there is a large number of people (~29,000 in September) who are awaiting case resolution on an ROR.



How does the pretrial population awaiting resolution of a VFO charge fare each month, in terms of rearrest?

Of the ~9,000 people who were awaiting resolution of their VFO case in the community in September, 96% were not rearrested at all that month, and 99% were not rearrested on a new VFO. This has remained relatively stable over time.

Note that unlike the pretrial NVF and misd populations, the pretrial VFO population is increasing over last year as cases linger and are not resolved



Most people awaiting their case resolution for their VFO case in the community each month are not rearrested that month regardless of the pretrial conditions under which they are waiting. In September, of the VFO pretrial population in the community:

- 96% of ROR'd people, 96.5% people who posted bail, and 94% on SR or DAT were not rearrested at all
- 99% of ROR'd people, people who posted bail, and people on SR, and 98% on a DAT, were not rearrested for a new VFO

Rearrests of the population in the community each month with a pending VFO, by pretrial status





Of the ~5-7% of the VFO pretrial population in the community who are rearrested each month, rearrests are distributed across crime types. Rearrests most often occur among those who are ROR'd (though the rate of VFO rearrest among this population is very low as the vast majority of ROR'd people awaiting their VFO case in the community each month are not rearrested).


Rearrests of the population in the community each month with a pending VFO, by pretrial status

The most common VFO rearrest pattern among people in the community with a pending VFO is repeat burglary. For the most part, people in other VFO categories are not docketed for repeat behavior rearrests at high rates.
