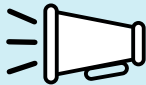

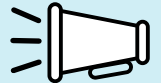

## EDUCATION SERVICES OPEN TO EVERYONE

### THE JOHN JAY COLLEGE INSTITUTE FOR JUSTICE AND OPPORTUNITY

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The John Jay College Institute for Justice and Opportunity offers a continuum of educational and career preparation services to individuals impacted by the criminal justice system. These programs include:

- **HSE Connect:** Supported High School Equivalency (HSE) program for adults 25+
- **College Initiative:** College access program for individuals with a high school diploma or HSE. Includes college readiness assessments, college exploration courses, academic and career counseling, assistance with college applications and financial aid applications, peer mentoring and support services.
- **Tech 101:** Introductory training on technology fundamentals including Microsoft Office and Google Suite, email basics, and online job searching.
- **Navigator Certificate in Human Services and Community Justice:** Semester-long intensive training for people with lived experience in the criminal justice system who are interested in a career in social services. Open to individuals 18+ with a high school diploma or HSE.
