5. The number of covered persons identified in paragraph 4 of this subdivision who were subsequently arraigned on a new offense within the prior 6 months.

As required by LL 75, the data included in this section reflects all individuals included in section 4 of this report who were arraigned within the 6 month period preceding the reporting date, whether or not the population review initiative contributed to the individual's earlier release.

912 unique individuals were released from jail during Q1 and Q2 2025. Each person was tracked for six months following their discharge from jail. For individuals released Q1/Q2 2025, 50.5% did not have a new arraignment in the six months following their release while 49.5% did.

There is a distinct difference in new prosecution rates when the released population is grouped by number of prior DOC admissions since 2020. 37% of people released during this time period had one or fewer prior jail admissions since 2020. This group was much less likely to have a new prosecuted arrest in the six months following their release than those with multiple prior



admissions. The 46% of people with 4 or more prior jail admissions were much more likely to have a new prosecuted arrest.
